Dear Parents/Guardians

Greetings from Malpi International School!

We have successfully completed one week of virtual classes. We are glad to see that our students have acclimated to this new norm. It is indeed a pleasure to see excellent attendance from most of our students. Please note that tomorrow, Wednesday, 26th May 2021 is marked as a holiday in our calendar on the auspicious occasion of Buddha Jayanti and we will not have our online classes tomorrow.

We are now in our 1st Periodic Performance Evaluations (P.P.E.) from the 17th May – 29th July 2021 (3rd Jestha - 8th Shrawan 2078). For this P.P.E, we have allocated 58 number of teaching days. Please note, that the students' progress is being evaluated constantly through the medium of regular tests, quizzes, project work, attendance and assignments. A formal 1st PPE will be taken from the 16th – 29th July 2021 (1st – 8th Shrawan). The results of the 1st P.P.E. will be sent to parents on the 6th Aug (22nd Shrawan).

Taking the feedback of a few parents, the online polls and student's and teacher's response in the google form, we have decided to hold the classes from Sunday to Friday like last year and give the weekend break on Saturdays for the online classes effective from 30th May onward. When we start the physical classes we could go back to our normal Sunday weekend.

We will be conducting an online Pre-SEE Examinations for our Grade X (SEE Batch) from Friday, 28th May 2021. This will be done through a different platform. We shall be using the proctoring system whereby we get a complete audio/visual feedback whilst the students are appearing for this examination. We request our parents of the SEE Batch to kindly arrange a silent corner/room, without disturbances during the examinations.

We are glad to welcome and invite our parents to a Webinar on, "COVID-19: The Science of Prevention and Well-being at Home", on Thursday, 27th May 2021 (13th Jestha 2078) from 5:00 p.m. onwards. This will take place virtually via ZOOM. Mr. Adarsh Man Sherchan our Consultant Molecular Biologist, will be the main speaker and facilitator for this webinar. The session will focus on providing information on understanding and preventing larger COVID outbreaks at homes or professional settings. The Webinar will also highlight much-needed and important information regarding tests, understanding of the disease and safety standards at home settings.
